1. ANNOUNCEMENT

- 1.1 The Cowra Motorcycle Racing Club, hereafter called the Promoter will conduct the 2020-21 NSW U16 250cc Speedway Solo Championships and the 2020-21 NSW U21 500cc Speedway Solo Championships at the Woodstock Park Speedway on Friday 12 February 2021.
- 1.2 The Cowra Motorcycle Racing Club, hereafter called the Promoter will conduct the 2020-21 NSW Open 500cc Speedway Solo Championships and the 2020-21 NSW U16 125cc Speedway Solo Championships at the Woodstock Park Speedway on Saturday 13 February 2021.
- 1.3 Supplementary Rain off schedule: If the meetings have to be postponed for the reason of force majeure the date will be Sunday 14 February 2021. If the rain date cannot be run in its entirety, but the meeting has reached 75% for all competitors, then a result may be declared by the referee based on the points at the time of the determination. If it has not reached 75%, then the event will be declared null and void and further decisions of status of this event are at the discretion of Motorcycling NSW.

2. JURISDICTION

- 2.1 The abovementioned meetings have been authorised by Motorcycling NSW which has issued the Motorcycling Australia Permit Number **[Insert Permit Number]** and is open to holders of current Motorcycling Australia National Competition Licences.
- 2.2 The meetings will be held in accordance with the current General Competition Rules (GCRs) contained in the Manual of Motorcycle Sport, these Supplementary Regulations, and any final instructions approved by Motorcycling NSW. By entering this meeting all parties agree to comply with these rules, regulations, by-laws and instructions.

4. ENTRIES

- 4.1 Please note this is a nomination only with the NSW Speedway Committee allocating the 16 spots for each Championship. You will be contacted shortly after the close of entries if you are successful or not. If unsuccessful, you will be given a full refund of entry fee.
- 4.2 Entries are now open and close last mail Friday 29 January 2021. Email to cookroof@bigpond.net.au or via post to Cowra Motorcycle Racing Club Inc. PO Box 446, Cowra NSW 2794. Late entries will not be accepted.
- 4.2 In the case of postponement or abandonment of the meeting, all or any part of the entry fee may be retained by the Cowra Motorcycle Racing Club, if such retention is approved by Motorcycling NSW.
- 4.3 Only entries received on the official entry form that is accompanied by the correct fee will be accepted.
- 4.4 Entry fees will only be refunded if a rider informs the Cowra Motorcycle Racing Club, in writing, 10 days before the event or rider is not in the 16 riders selected by Motorcycling

NSW Speedway Sports Committee and does not wish to ride as a Reserve. A medical certificate is required if a rider withdraws less than 10 days before the event.

5. ENTRY FEE

6. ENTRY PASSES

- 6.1 Solo Championship entries will receive a rider and one mechanic pass at the gate upon entry to the event.

7. INSURANCE

- 7.1 National Personal Accident Scheme provides basic cover for death and permanent disability.
- 7.2 Ambulance Insurance is compulsory for licensees.
It is strongly recommended that competitors give consideration to taking out weekly benefits insurance.

8. MEDICAL SERVICES

Medical Australia will be in attendance from start of practice to the end of the race meeting/presentation.

9. SCRUTINEERING

- 9.1 Scrutineering will begin at 4.00 pm for all Championship Events. For further information see Section **14. Event Schedule**.
- 9.2 Machines entered in the competition must have successfully passed a machine examination prior to taking part in practice, qualifying or racing. An MA decal will be placed on the front number plate to indicate that it has been successfully examined.
- 9.3 Current competition licences and full riding gear must be presented at scrutineering. Eligibility checks can take place at any time during the meeting. Machines which suffer accident damage in practice or race sessions must be re-examined before participating again.
- 9.4 In addition to supervising the pulling down and checking of machines after official protests have been received by the Clerk of Course in accordance with the GCRs, the Referee can order that any machine be measured and if this occurs the Scrutineer will supervise a team member to pull down any machine that has taken part in the event. Failure to comply with this regulation will result in this matter being referred to the Clerk of Course for further action.
- 9.5 Machines will not be sealed for later checking after the event. All machines that are to be pulled down and scrutineered will take place at the circuit before the machine is released by the Scrutineer. A member of the rider's team must be available at all times to carry out the

strip down under the control of the Scrutineer. Failure to comply with this regulation will result in this matter being referred to the Clerk of Course for further action.

10. CLASSES OF COMPETITION & ENTRIES TO CONSTITUTE A CLASS

- 10.1 Class of Competition and entries to constitute a class for the purpose of gaining Championship status, the number of contestants entered and competing in each class shall be as follows:

- 10.2 Should there be insufficient entries in any class of competition, the decision to run or cancel the class, or to combine events and re-distribute any awards and/or prizemoney, will be at the discretion of Cowra Motorcycle Racing Club, subject to Motorcycling NSW approval.

11. STARTS

Starts will be done by Speedway tapes and green lights as per GCRs. Practice starts are not permitted at the main starting area.

12. VESTS

Riding Vests will be provided and must be worn by the Rider.

13. RACE FORMAT

U16 125cc, U16 250 & U21 500cc

- 13.1 The Championships will be twenty (20) heats, one (1) B Final and one (1) A final with four (4) riders in each.

- 13.2 All heats and finals will be over four (4) laps

13.3 Finals

B Final

Event 21 will be the B Final.

The riders for the B Final will be 4th, 5th, 6th and 7th point scorers after 20 heats.

The winner of the B Final will go to the A Final, 2nd, 3rd, 4th in the B final will determine who is 5th, 6th and 7th in the Championship.

A Final

Event 22 will be the A Final.

The top three (3) point scorers will go direct to the A final, plus the winner of the B Final. The placegetters in this final will determine who is 1st, 2nd, 3rd and 4th in the Championship.

- 13.4 If riders are tied on Points for the A or B final, the Count Back System will determine any ties.

- 13.5 Scoring as per GCR 14.10.17. Points for meetings, including the A & B Final, will be as follows:

1 st Position	=	Three (3) points
2 nd Position	=	Two (2) points
3 rd Position	=	One (1) point
4 th Position	=	Zero (0) points

Open 500cc

13.6 There will be twenty (20) heats, two (2) Semi Finals and one (1) Final with four (4) riders in each

13.7 ALL heats and Finals will be over four (4) laps.

13.8 Finals

Semi Final one (1) will be made up of the 1st, 3rd, 5th and 7th placed competitors after the twenty (20) heats.

Semi Final two (2) will be made up of the 2nd, 4th, 6th and 8th placed competitors after the twenty (20) heats.

Final will be made up of the 1st and 2nd placed competitors from Semi Final one (1) and two (2). The place getters in this Final will determine who is 1st, 2nd, 3rd and 4th for the meeting.

13.9 If rider's tie on points for the 1st or 2nd Semi-finals, the count back system will determine any ties. As per the GCR's the finishing order of each competitor in the Final will determine the Championship placings. After completion of the series, if any of the top 4 point scorers are tied then the respective positions shall be decided by a run-off.

13.10 Scoring as per GCR 14.10.17. Points for meetings, including Semi Finals and Final will be as follows:

1 st Position	=	Three (3) points
2 nd Position	=	Two (2) points
3 rd Position	=	One (1) point
4 th Position	=	Zero (0) points

13.12 Non finishers will receive one of the following alongside their names on the score sheet:

- M** (excluded due to 2 minute rule)
- R** (retired from the race)
- F** (fall but not excluded)
- T** (excluded for false start)
- D** (excluded)
- N** (Non-started)

Practice shall be in Race Draw Format eg: 1 - 4, 5 - 8, 9 - 12 and 13 - 16.

For the purposes of drug and alcohol testing, the commencement of the meetings will be deemed to be 4pm with the completion of the meeting for the participant being when the participant has vacated the venue.

15. **AWARDS AND PRIZEMONEY**

15.1 MNSW Medallions will be presented to the first 3 place getters in all Championships.

15.2 NSW U16 125cc & U16 250cc Speedway Solo Championships
Trophies and prizes for 1st to 4th positions in the A Final.

15.3 NSW U21 Speedway Solo Championship
\$20 a point will be paid for the twenty heats only.

16. PAYG

PAYG Withholding affects the payment of prizemoney. 17. PRESENTATIONS

On track and Clubhouse at the completion of the program.

18. MACHINES AND RIDERS

18.1 All machines entered must comply with the current GCRs for Speedway Solo competition.

18.2 Multiple entry of the one machine in the same class of competition is not permitted.

18.3 Change of machine is allowed during competition by notifying the Clerk of the Course.

19. GRID POSITIONS

Grid positions shall be determined by Motorcycling NSW Speedway Sports Committee.

20. RIDERS' BRIEFING

A riders' briefing will be held prior to the commencement of racing, which ALL competitors MUST attend.

21. CIRCUIT DESCRIPTION

The surface of the Senior (310 metres in length) and Junior Track (110 metres in length) is crushed watered granite.

22. TRACK INSPECTION

22.1 All competitors will be given the opportunity to walk and inspect the track prior to any on track participation. This inspection must be done on foot and competitors are reminded that service vehicles may be in operation on the circuit at this time.

22.2 Track Dissatisfaction - Competitors who are not satisfied with any aspects of the track can present these concerns to the Clerk of Course if those concerns cannot be resolved, the competitor will be invited to withdraw from the meeting.

23. FACILITIES

Canteen and Amenities Blocks (including showers) are available.

24. NOISE

Noise testing may take place at any time at the discretion of the Chief Scrutineer or the Clerk of Course.

25. TYRES

As per GCRs.

26. ANTI-DOPING POLICY

26.1 All competitors, crew, parents / guardians and officials are advised that drug testing may take place in accordance with MA's Anti-Doping Policy, under the authority of Sport Integrity Australia.

26.2 Athletes are advised to download the Sports Integrity Australia app. If athletes have any doubts over Sports Integrity Australia requirements they should visit the website www.sportintegrity.gov.au

It is recommended athletes contact the Drugs in Sport Hotline (1300 027 232) for further information. When drug testing takes place, the payment of prize money may be delayed, at the discretion of MA, until the results of the tests are known.

27. DRUG AND ALCOHOL TESTING

All competitors and officials are advised that random drug and alcohol testing may take place during the competition. Refer to MA website for details on the Safety Policy – Drug and Alcohol testing.

28. CODES OF BEHAVIOUR

All competitors, officials and parents are reminded of MA's Codes of Behaviour contained within MA's Member Protection Regulations, found at www.ma.org.au which is a guide to appropriate behaviour at all motorcycle race meetings. These Codes of Behaviour apply to this meeting and will be enforced.

29. FIRE EXTINGUISHERS

All riders must have a minimum 2kg, dry powder A:B (E) class, working fire extinguisher in their pit area

30. ELECTRONIC COMMUNICATIONS AND SOCIAL MEDIA

All competitors, officials and parents are bound by of MA's Social Media Policy, found at www.ma.org.au, which sets out a framework for acceptable online behaviour where communications involve fellow MA members, volunteers, officials, coaches, sponsors, partners, staff and any other connected persons, penalties may apply for breaches of the policy.

32. ENVIROMENTAL RESPONSIBILITY

All teams and riders are responsible for the removal of all items including rubbish from their pit area as they vacate the premises. Penalties may apply as per GCR 6.1.1.1(a). Used tyres cannot be left on site. Any rider found to have left tyres in the pit area will be fined for the cost of their disposal.

33. SPECIAL NOTE

Armbands will be issued at sign-on for pit area for riders and one mechanic only. Anyone without a wrist band will be asked to leave the area.
